Keeping their privacy settings as high as possible.

Ensuring their personal locations are kept secret at all times.

Discussing the dangers of meeting up in the real world with 'online friends'. THEY OFTEN AREN'T WHO THEY SAY THEY ARE!

Only allowing age-appropriate apps and games. Social media accounts have a minimum age limit due to their often inappropriate content.

Making a family agreement, which you can all use to stay safe, with agreed sites to use and time limits for being online.

Sharing and being involved with their online life, always knowing who they are talking to and the sites they are exploring.

Telling them that making, possessing and distributing any imagery of someone under 18 which is 'indecent' is illegal. This includes imagery of themselves if they are under 18.
