

SJV SCHOOL UNIFORM LIST

The Governors have approved the uniform to be worn and parents are asked to co-operate by providing the following items and insisting upon their children being properly dressed. It is necessary for each item of clothing, footwear etc. to have the child's name attached, clearly. One piece of school uniform looks similar to another. The school cannot accept liability for the loss of personal property.

COMPULSORY ITEMS:

Primary Uniform

Skirt/Pinafore -	Green
Trousers/Shorts -	Grey
Shirt/Blouse -	Plain white (not polo shirt)
Tie -	Regulation Green and Gold Striped
Jumper/Cardigan -	Green knitted with embroidered badge (no sweatshirts)

Nursery Uniform

Nursery sweatshirt -	Yellow embroidered (nursery children only)
Nursery polo t-shirt -	Plain white/White embroidered (nursery children only)
Shoes -	Black with straps or laces

P.E. Kit

P.E. T-shirt -	Green embroidered
Shorts -	Black
Tracksuit top -	Green/black embroidered
Tracksuit bottoms -	Plain black leggings or tracksuit pants or school tracksuit bottoms
Pumps -	Black

OPTIONAL ITEMS

Primary Uniform

Summer dress -	Green gingham
Year 6 Fleece -	Green embroidered

Trainers -	Plain. For outdoor P.E. lessons only

HAIR

Hair should be well groomed and of reasonable length. Shaved heads (as a general guide a "Number 3" is the shortest permissible cut), shave lines, steps, Mohicans etc. are not acceptable. We ask that children with shoulder-length or longer hair make sure that it is tied back daily with plain bobbles/headband. Headbands should be simple and not large or decorative. No other hair accessories may be worn. No coloured hair braids/hair jewellery/ hair extensions.

MAKE-UP

No make-up, no fake tan, no false nails, no nail varnish, no temporary tattoos.

JEWELLERY

May not be worn in school- Health & Safety guidelines. The exceptions to this rule are ear-ring studs in pierced ears and watches. We ask the children to either remove these objects during PE and games, or cover them with a plaster (brought from home) to prevent them from causing injury.
