Welcome to Year 1! Throughout the year our children develop their independence as well as their reading, writing, number and problem- solving skills. We spend time ensuring children learn through exploration in our provision areas as well as developing the children's independent skills through group and whole class tasks.

Our Year 1 curriculum is based around novels and includes a mixture of independent activities alongside teacher led, paired group and individual tasks. Oracy, P4C, Metacognition and Journaling weaves together all our teaching and learning across the curriculum.

Phonics plays a large part of the Year 1 curriculum as we teach children how to read, write and spell. Reading at home will support your child in their learning journey and will help embed the skills that they are developing in school.

Throughout Year 1, children are given the opportunity to take part in a range of activities including a trip to the theatre, trips exploring our local area, a trip to a farm, cooking, growing plants and vegetables and visits to Stanley Park.
